***What's At Stake In This Election***

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The KPPCSD Board has been working diligently to secure a new location for our police department and District personnel. The current space in the PSB is inadequate and will be even less in the renovated PSB. The Kensington Police Department has seen a complete turnaround in both personnel and longterm fiscal outlook. The department is nearly fully staffed and the Board has brought the cost of health care and pension obligations under control. But failure to fit our KPD in a modern facility will jeopardize our future ability to attract good candidates for both police and district positions.

*Facts about relocating our District office:*

- A portion of the park parking lot was prioritized after obtaining a professional architectural survey of property that the District already owns.
- A geological study is now being conducted to check if this site is suitable.
- The District would not have to lease or purchase land - saving both money and time.
- The District has designed and constructed a modular headquarters in El Cerrito to meet modern police department standards and can be relocated to Kensington.
- This modular District Headquarters would be a fraction of the cost of new construction.
- The KPPCSD is committed to researching alternative sites within Kensington. Options are limited in our District but we continue the search.
